Using simple materials of pencil and paper, Darlene will teach workshop participants to draw a fox or a bear. This workshop is all-ages and suitable for children!

Bracelet-Making with Mariela Vega

10:00am – 10:50am

A workshop for young people and children to make their own bracelets with step-by-step direction.

Acrylic Painting with Colette Tanel

12:00pm – 12:50pm

A step-by-step instruction workshop to learn to paint a cheery sunflower using acrylic painting techniques. This workshop is all-ages and suitable for children!

Watercolour and Pen Landscapes with Stephanie Schrimm

12:00pm – 12:50pm

Students will learn to create a landscape by using simple shapes, apply colour with watercolour paint and add contour with a fine tip pen. Suitable for beginner to advanced artists of all ages.

Loom Weaving with Deniree Isabel

1:00pm – 1:50pm

Create textural imagery and colour that, when finished, can be hung. Using a cardboard loom, learn to weave: plain weave, twill, sumac and other fun textural weaves. Anyone under 10 should be accompanied with an adult!

Mosaic Pots with Lucent Glass & Art

1:00pm – 1:50pm

Using a variety of bright colours, customize a small flowerpot with pieces of glass. This workshop is recommended for older children and adults as guests will be using glass materials.

Botanical Dyes with Miriam Kaufman

2:00pm – 2:50pm

Use native botanicals to dye two 10" X 10" cotton squares for quilting, patches or other sewing projects. Learn a technique that you can use at home with flowers from your garden and items from your kitchen, using your microwave. Suitable for children in grade 1 or higher, must be supervised by an accompanying adult if under 13.
